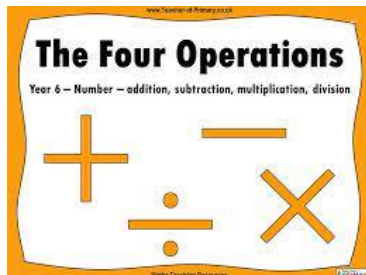


Year 4 Summer Term Curriculum letter

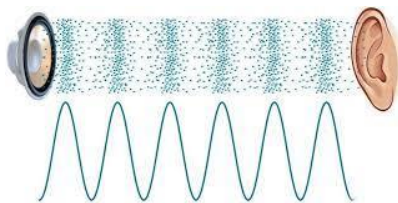
Welcome back and we hope you had a fantastic Easter holiday. This letter will detail what Year 4 class will be learning over the Summer term.



In Maths, we will be developing our understanding of the four functions. We will be adding and subtracting four-digit numbers and multiplying and dividing 4-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers, including solving 2-step problems. We will be looking at angles, shapes and negative numbers. We will continue to look at

telling and working with time in 12- and 24-hour clock. Frequent times tables practice will continue to be completed as we approach our times tables test this term. Please encourage your children to continue with regularly accessing TT Rockstars!

In English, we will be exploring portal stories such as Alice in Wonderland to then write our own portal story. We will also create engaging and descriptive poetry by using all our amazing year 4 writing skills. We will also become journalists in the classroom and create newspaper reports, describing events that have taken place. We will continue to work on our punctuation, handwriting and spellings as we complete our work.



In Science, we are learning about sound. We will discover and explore the ways in which it travels and how different materials can absorb sound. We will explore how instruments create vibrations and even create our own instrument!

This term in History we will be learning all about What Life was like in Anglo-Saxon Britain. We will also be learning about how life changed as a result of the Viking invasion.



In PSHE we will be learning more about how to be healthy, both physically and mentally. We will be exploring relationships and ways in which we can help our friends feel happy and how we can treat ourselves as well as we can.

In Art and Design and Technology we will be designing and creating wire sculptures. In R.E. we will be exploring Judaism and Christianity with the children.

In P.E we will be focusing on Netball and Athletics among other skills. Our PE days remain on Thursday when swimming will also continue to take place. However, some weeks the PE day might change. For summer 1, the PE day will be on a Wednesday. However, please keep an eye on class dojo as some weeks this may change and it may be different in Summer 2. The majority of the P.E lessons will take place outdoors so please ensure proper kits are complete and in school. As the weather grows warmer, please ensure that your child has a water bottle in every day.
