

Vision statement for DT

At Purford Green our vision for DT is to equip children with skills and knowledge to become confident, resourceful and responsible designers and makers. We believe that engaging in hands on learning experiences fosters a sense of ownership and pride, allowing pupils to understand the value of their ideas in shaping the world around them.

During their time at Purford Green, all children will acquire 3 key life skills:

1. Sewing
2. Cooking
3. Constructing



We feel these skills are necessary to help our children in their lives now and as they grow. We aim for children to leave year 6 with the ability to look use these key skills confidently and successfully.

We want children to

- Learn life skills such as sewing, cooking and use of tools. Learning is recapped, taught and built upon in real life situations to allow children to learn and embed knowledge and skills.
- Have a clear learning objective that children can explain and assess themselves against. This may also allow for peer assessment through discussion and evaluation
- Design and create and evaluate different products
- Use a variety of resources/ equipment to help aid, support and progress learning.
- Experience a variety of learning opportunities. These may be hands on, practical learning, research-based tasks or more discussion-based activities that allow children to all share their understanding and learning.
- See links with other curriculum areas so that children can see how some skills are transferable and may help us in other real-life situations.
