

# Year 4 Summer Term Curriculum Letter

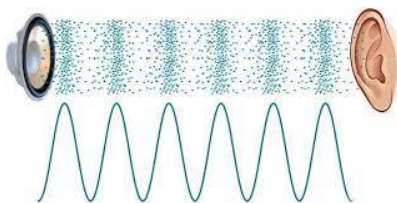
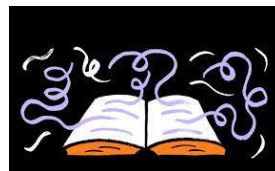
Welcome back and we hope you had a fantastic Easter holiday. This letter will detail what Year Four will be learning over the Summer Term.

In *Maths*, we will be developing our understanding of the four operations. We will be adding and subtracting four-digit numbers and multiplying and dividing 4-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers, including solving 2-step problems. We will be looking at angles, shapes and negative numbers.

Frequent *times tables practice* will continue to be completed as we approach our times tables test this term, alongside TTR Club after school. Please encourage your children to continue with regularly accessing TT Rockstars!

In *English*, we will be exploring portal stories such as *Alice in Wonderland* to then write our own portal story. We will also be learning and performing a poem. We will become journalists in the classroom and create newspaper reports, describing events that have taken place. We will continue to work on our punctuation, handwriting and spellings as we complete our work.



In *Science*, we are learning about sound. We will discover and explore the ways in which it travels and how different materials can absorb sound. We will explore how instruments create vibrations and even create our own instrument!

This term in *History* we will be learning all about 'What Life was like in Anglo-Saxon Britain' and why the Romans left Britain. We will also be learning about how life changed as a result of the Viking invasion and how this impacted the country.

In **PSHE** we will be learning more about how to be healthy, both physically and mentally. We will be exploring relationships and ways in which we can help our friends feel happy and how we can treat ourselves as well as we can.



In **Art** we will be designing and creating wire sculptures, and in **DT** we will be constructing our own houses with a variety of mechanisms.

In **R·E** we will be exploring Judaism and Christianity with the children. We will also be visiting the local Synagogue - more information will follow.

In **P·E** we will be focusing on Fitness and Athletics among other skills. Our PE days continue to be on **Wednesday and Thursday** when swimming will also continue to take place for some children. The majority of the P·E lessons will take place outdoors now that the weather is better so please ensure that kits are suitable for outdoor PE and in school at all times.

As the weather grows warmer, please ensure that your child has a water bottle in school every day and that they come to school wearing sun cream and a hat on hot days.
