<p>Practice telling the time. By the end of year three the expectation is that you can tell the time to the nearest minute but don't worry if you can't yet. Start with o'clock and half past times and then move on to quarter past and to times. You can do this throughout the day and doesn't need to be written down.</p> <p>Write a fact family for 8, 7, 56, x, ÷ and =</p> <p align="center">For example $3 \times 8 = 24$ $8 \times 3 = 24$ $24 \div 3 = 8$ $24 \div 8 = 3$</p> <p>Look at the maths questions at the end of this document. Ideas include – what have you been watching on TV, have you seen any rainbows in windows, how are you feeling? You could even learn a joke to tell them!</p>

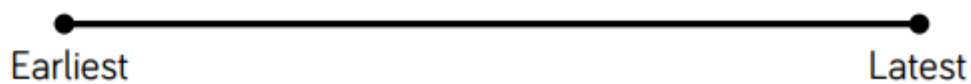

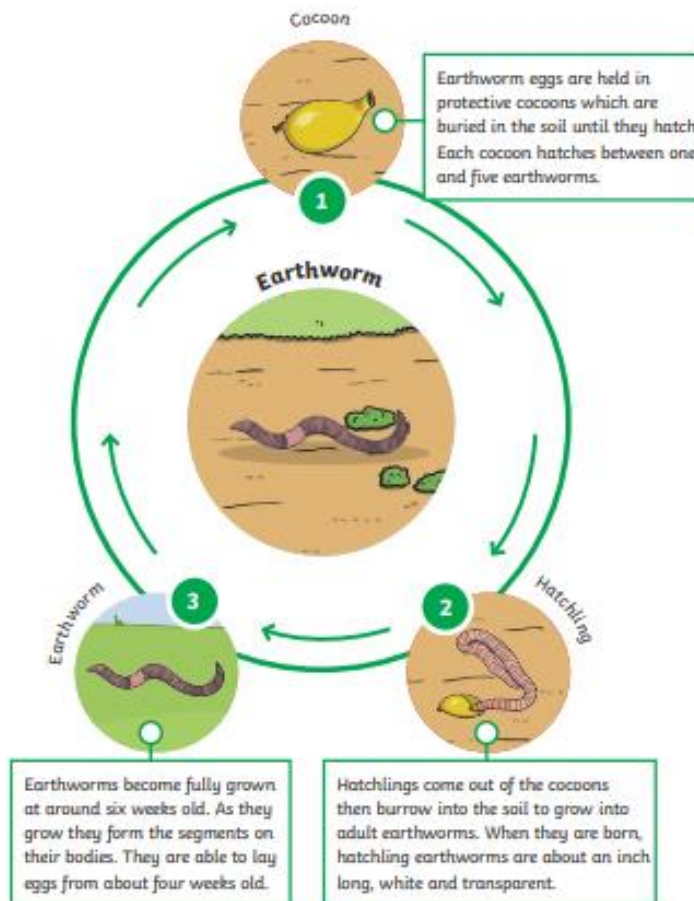
